## **Philippine Village Historical Site 1904**

The Philippine Village at the 1904 World's Fair covered 47 acres in the Wydown-Skinker neighborhood. During the fair, over 1,000 people from the Philippines lived in replicas of their villages at home and performed their daily activities for fairgoers. Everyone returned home except for several who died from sickness. All of the structures were demolished after the fair.
