✚ Clayton Complete Streets Policy

- Matt updated the committee regarding a few changes that he made to the draft of the new Clayton Complete Streets Policy.
- The draft is scheduled to be an informational discussion at the Board of Alderman's meeting – February 9th

✚ John's Updates

- Susan Pizzaz's - Questions Updates
 - City participation in Recycling Program – Susan spoke with Louisville, KY who has had extreme success – use of a 3rd party to promote called “Recycle Coach”; which use social media for advertising
 - Idle time difference backdoor vs curbside service
 - 63 seconds per home for back door
 - 29 seconds curb service
 - Band on plastic bags – working on more information on other sources around the state's ordinance.
 - Committee had a general conversation regarding rear yard pick up vs curb side and trash contract.
- 2020 Campaign Sign Recycling Event
 - 1st time event – Center of Clayton
 - Metal and plastic signs can be recycled
 - November 14th – volunteers collected
 - 72 corrugated plastic signs
 - 13 cardboard signs
 - 5 plastic signs
 - Positive feed back
 - Recommend we participate next year as well
- City's St. Louis Green Business Challenge Award
 - Virtual event
 - City received a plaque made from recycling material along with a handwritten letter from Jean Pozzi, thanking the city for its participation.
 - Report sent out as well, with each city having its own page with their different ideas, accomplishments, and percentages.
