The following restrictions must be adhered:

- 1. Painted, creosoted, wolmanized or otherwise treated wood cannot be used to fuel the fire.
- 2. The fire cannot be used to dispose of food or rubbish waste.
- 3. The fire must be completely extinguished before sponsors of the fire leave the premises.
- 4. If smoke, ash or particulate matter from any recreational fire remains visible beyond the property line of origin or found on surfaces beyond the property line of origin, it shall be a violation of Missouri Air Pollution Control. Any violation of the Missouri Air Pollution Control Rules can result in a fine from the State of Missouri. See section 612.340 below:

612.340 - Air Pollution Nuisances Prohibited

It is unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to permit or cause the escape of such quantities of soot, cinders, noxious acids, fumes and gases or other particulate matter from whatever source in such place or manner as to be detrimental to any person or to the public or to endanger the health, comfort and safety of any such person or the public, or in such manner as to cause or have a tendency to cause injury or damage to property or business. The escape of such matter is declared to be a public nuisance. Each day wherein a violation of this section occurs shall constitute a separate offense.
