  - 1,000-2,000 people




# WHO IS MIKE SILVERMAN?

### RESPONSIBILITIES

- Silverman Brothers Responsibilities
  - Find and contract local jazz musicians to perform
  - Rental of stage from Clancy
  - Bring in sound, lighting and electric

- Production Estimate Cost Breakdown:
  - Musician/Act: \$150 per musician per act
  - Sound & Operator: \$1,000
  - **Electric:** \$4,000
  - **Stage:** \$2,500
  - **Approx. Total:** \$10,000

- City's Responsibilities
  - Book restaurant vendors
  - Rental of chairs & restrooms
  - Book contract labor & OT staff
  - Marketing
  - Find sponsors

- Production Estimate Cost Breakdown:
  - **Vendors:** \$500
  - Chair Rental: \$350
  - Portable Restrooms: \$400
  - **Contract Labor:** \$1,000
  - **Staff OT:** \$3,500
  - **Marketing:** \$5,000
  - **Approx. Total:** \$10,750

## JAZZ FESTIVAL EVENT BUDGET

**Proposed Revenue:** \$3,750 (Sponsorship)

**Proposed Net:** \$17,000

**Estimated Event Attendance:** 1,500

Cost Per Attendee: \$11.30

### EVENT TO REPLACE

- Clayton's Brews, Blues & BBQ Festival
  - Local microbrew festival with BBQ
- Why replace?
  - Competed with too many like-minded, beer festivals in the St. Louis area
  - Microbreweries only participate in so many events per year due to costs and supply; interest was shrinking
    - Microbreweries focus on larger, more recognizable events like Microfest in Forest Park, Oktoberfest, Hop in the City, etc.
  - Clayton community not as interested in beer festivals
