- Landscaping With Native Plants is Naturescaping
 - Less Watering—Lower Water Bill
 - More Tree Cover—Lower Electric (and perhaps Gas) Bill
 - Reduce Storm Runoff—Potential to Lower Sewer Bill
 - Less Grass to Mow—Cheaper Lawn Maintenance
 - Reduced Greenhouse Gas Emissions
 - Nature Experience at Your Own Home—Priceless
 - Reduced Pesticide/Herbicide Use
 - Potentially Higher Property Values

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

- Landowner Must Commit to Healthy Yard Pledge
 - Reduce Pesticide Use
 - Conserve Water
 - Protect Water Quality
 - Remove Invasive Exotic Plants
 - Plant Native Species
 - Support Birds and Other Wildlife on Their Property
- On-Line Application Is Then Submitted
- Property is Scheduled for Site Visit
- Homeowner Pays Fee for Service
 - \$25 if SLAS/Partner Member, \$50 Otherwisε



PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

- Habitat Advisors Tour Property & Interview Owner
 - Discuss Owner's Vision and Goals for the Property
 - Determine Site Characteristics—Moisture, Sunlight, Use, etc.
 - Inventory Existing Plants—Native and Exotic
 - Present Big-Picture Ideas to Improve Habitat Value
- Resource Packet Provided to Owner
- Written Recommendations Delivered in 7-14 Days
 - Outlines Steps to Achieve Certification at One of Three Levels
 - Most Steps Include Homeowner Options
- Owner Requests Follow-up
- Advisor Returns to Certify Site
